

# Cub Scout Behavior Management Ideas Shared at Roundtable

---

- Talking Feather
  - Similar to a talking stick. The boy may only speak when he is holding the feather.
  - The feather (actually multiple feathers) can be made by the boys as a project in a den meeting.
- Walking Stick
  - Boys are presented with a bare walking (large dowel) stick at the beginning of the year.
  - At the start of each meeting the sticks are placed against one wall.
  - A bad behavior moves the stick to the other wall as a warning.
  - Two bad behaviors means they lose their embellishment
  - Every den meeting they make or earn a new embellishment for the walking stick by being on their best behavior.
- Den Chiefs
  - Assist the den leaders during den and pack meetings.
- Parent Involvement
  - Parents are asked to attend all den and pack meetings to help monitor their kids.
- Den Leaders
  - Den Leaders sit with their dens during the pack meetings.
